
SQUID'S **watery** habitat is in the Pacific Ocean as well as some other areas.

## Polar Bears

Fierce Polar bears have interesting skin, because they have a thick layer of **blubber** beneath their fur, which provides warmth. The blubber is black so it **absorbs** heat, but their fur appears white to blend in with their **environment**. Polar bears that rapidly wander into villages can be dangerous to people, they

usually end up in death. Polar bears are large shocking **mammals**

and they are about 3 . 4-8m long, 1.6m high if they stand on their hind legs and 400-800kg. They also loudly devour ring and bearded seals, lemmings, bird eggs, young walruses, dead whales and berries. The most important **habitat** for Polar bears are the **edges** of **packed** ice where **currents** and wind interact **forming** continuous ice patches.

### Movement

Did you know that the polar bears have interesting way of surviving the freezing **ecosystems**

Polar bears swim elegantly because they have **wide** front paws and **slightly webbed** toes, they paddle with their front legs and **steers** with their hind legs their paws have **paw pads** with **rough surfaces** and that **prevents** them from **slipping** on ice.

### Migration

Polar bears **migrate** north because as **temperatures** are **rising** and the ice in the Arctic is **melting**. The Arctic sea ice is melting because of **climate change**, polar bears appeared to be creeping their way towards villages in Canada.

### Food chain

Most Arctic mammals mainly munch seals, but sometimes whales and baby walrus. Polar bears are keeping the **ecosystem** in **balance**.

Global warming also melts the ice which algae on the bottom


Algae is one of the main prey and the bottom on the food chain next to phytoplankton.


